- His iconic speech at the 1893 Parliament of the World's Religions in Chicago brought him global prominence.
- **Statement 3** – On July 4, 1902, he went to his room at Belur Math (the headquarters of the Ramakrishna Mission near Kolkata) and passed away while meditating.
- His disciples state that he attained Mahasamadhi.
