It aims to promote productivity in all sectors of Indian economy. It is presided by Union Minister of Commerce and Industry. Asian Productivity Organization is a Tokyo based organization of which India is a founding member.

The unusual marine flowering plants are called *seagrasses* because in many species the leaves are long and narrow, grow by rhizome extension, and often grow in large "meadows", which look like grassland. Seagrass is characterized by widespread latitudinal range. Seagrass beds are highly diverse and productive ecosystems, and can harbor hundreds of associated species. Seagrasses are sometimes labeled ecosystem engineers, because they partly create their own habitat: their leaves, by slowing down water currents, increase sedimentation, and their roots and rhizomes stabilize the seabed. seagrasses were collected as fertilizer for sandy soil.

Birds are excellent indicators of ecosystem health. The IBA programme of Birdlife International aims to identify, monitor and protect a global network of IBAs for conservation of the world's birds and associated biodiversity.

namely (i) hold significant numbers of one or more globally threatened bird species, (ii) be one of a set of sites that together hold a suite of restricted-range species or biome-restricted species and (iii) have exceptionally large numbers of migratory or congregatory birds.

It provides for speedy investigation and trial, which must be completed in two months. It proposes 6 months' time limit for disposal of appeals in rape. It provides no provision for anticipatory bail for person accused of rape or gang rape of girl under 16 years.
