Indus River - Originate in a glacier near Bokar Chu in Kailash Mountain Range

Himalayan tributaries - Shyok, Gilgit, Zaskar, Hunza, Nubra, Shigar, Gasting and Dras

Tributaries that originate in Sulaiman ranges - Khurram, Tochi, Viboa and Sangar

02. Which of the following are the left bank tributaries of Yamuna River?

Yamuna River originate in the Yamunotri glacier on the western slopes of Bunderpanch Range.

Right Bank Tributaries - Chambal, Sind, Betwa and Ken.

Left Bank Tributaries - Hindan, Rind, Sengar and Varuna.

Alaknanda River has its source in Satopanth glacier. Alaknandha and Bagirathi river meet at Devprayag, hereafter it is known as Ganga. Tributaries of Alaknandha are Pindar, Mandakini or Kali Ganga.

Ganga River System includes both perennial and non-perennial rivers. Yamuna has its source in Yamunotri glacier near Banderpunch Range. Yamuna joins Ganga at Allahabad (Prayag).

Under the Unnat Bharat Abhiyan 2.0, the premier institutions have been selected on a Challenge Mode and the scheme has been extended to 750 reputed Higher Educational Institutes (both public and private) of the country. IIT Delhi has been designated to function as the National Coordinating Institute for this programme and the Ministry intends to extend the coverage to all the reputed Higher Educational Institutes, in a phased manner. Each selected institute would adopt a cluster of

villages / panchayats and gradually expand the outreach over a period of time.
