- 1) Consider the following statements with respect to Gateway of India
 - 1. It is an arch monument built during 20th century.
 - 2. It was erected to commemorate the Indian soldiers who lost their lives fighting for the British Army during the World War I.
 - 3. It is built in Indo-Saracenic style.

Which of the statement(s) given above is/are correct?

Answer: c

- The Maharashtra government has recently initiated a plan to clean, restore and beautify the iconic Gateway of India in South Mumbai.
- The Gateway of India is an arch monument built during the 20th century.
- The iconic structure, which overlooks the Arabian Sea, was erected to commemorate the visit of *King George V and Queen Mary* at Apollo Bunder to Mumbai.
- The foundation stone of the monument was laid on March 31, 1913 and its construction was completed in 1924.
- It is built in *Indo-Saracenic style*.
- **India Gate** which stands at the centre of New Delhi commemorates the 70,000 Indian soldiers who lost their lives fighting for the British Army during the World War I.
- The memorial bears the names of more than 13,516 British and Indian soldiers killed in the North-western Frontier in the Afghan war of 1919.

- The "mega themes" to be addressed during the event are clean oceans, climate finance, energy transitions, mobility and sustainable agriculture.

- Swachh Shakti-2019 is a *national event* which aims to bring in to focus the leadership role played by rural women in Swachh Bharat Mission.
- Women *Sarpanches and Panches* from *all over the country* will be attending the event.
- The Ministry of *Drinking Water and Sanitation* in association with the *Govt. of Haryana* is organizing the Swachh Shakti-2019.
- Best practices from grass root level in the rural areas for Swachh Bharat will be shared by them.
- The event will showcase the achievements of Swachh Bharat and the recently conducted Swachh Sunder Shauchalay, (neat and clean toilet) a unique and first of its kind in the world campaign.
- 4) Blue Flame Revolution sometimes seen in the news recently, is associated with which of the following?

- The focus of the programme was to be on less privileged children residing in **backward areas** by interacting with them in **vernacular languages** for their better understanding.
- Intermittently programme was given to Centre for Cultural Resources and Training (CCRT), an autonomous organization working under the purview of Ministry of Culture.
- 6) *DD Arunprabha*, a dedicated 24x7 Doordarshan satellite channel was launched recently for which of the following states?

- Through this channel news of even remote places in the state will reach the people.

- Researchers believe that the 'Aryans of Ladakh' or the 'Brokpas' are descendants of Alexander's army and had come to the region over 2,000 years ago.
