1) Consider the following statements with respect to TROPEX-19

- 1. It is an annual joint naval exercise among the tropical countries.
- 2. All the three services of Indian defence forces participated in the event.

Which of the statement(s) given above is/are correct?

Answer : b

- Theatre Level Operational Readiness Exercise (TROPEX 19) is the *largest War Game of the Indian Navy*.
- The exercise had commenced on 07 January 2019.
- Earlier, TROPEX 19 had commenced with *Tri-services Amphibious Exercise* in the *Andaman & Nicobar Islands* with participation of *Indian Army and Indian Air Force*.
- This was followed by the largest Coastal Defence Exercise code named **SEA VIGIL**' on 22 January and 23 January 2019 with participation of all 13 Coastal States and Union Territories along with all maritime stakeholders.

- The Rome Statute is multilateral treaty which serves as ICC's foundational and governing document.
- India is not a signatory to the Statute.
- USA and China is also non-signatory of the statute.
- Its headquarters is located in *The Hague, Netherlands*.

- All Public servants and all entities receiving donations from foreign sources in excess of Rs. 10 Lakh per year come under the purview of the Lokpal.
- But the Armed forces do not come under its ambit.
- All public Servants include:
- 1. Prime Minister
- 2. Ministers
- 3. Member of Parliament
- 4. Groups A, B, C and D officers and
- 5. Central Government officials
- However, the Lokpal shall not inquire into any allegation of corruption against a former or current PM if they are related to International relations, external and internal security, Public order, atomic energy and space.

- Twin pit systems are a type of toilet system.
- Under the twin-pit latrine system, two pits are dug with honeycombed walls and earthen floors which allow liquid to percolate into the surrounding soil. When one pit is filled and closed off, waste flow is transferred to the second pit, allowing waste in the first pit to be converted into manure after a year or two.
- The twin pit has been promoted by the *Ministry of Drinking Water and Sanitation* and the *World Health Organisation* as an *in-situ sanitation system*, which claims to bypass thorny issues as owners will be dealing with manure, not excreta.

Such number of Members, not exceeding eight out of whom fifty per cent shall be Judicial Members: Provided that not less than fifty per cent of the Members of the Lokpal shall be from amongst the persons belonging to the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, Other Backward Classes, Minorities and women.

- Janani Shishu Suraksha Karyakram entitles all pregnant women delivering in public health institutions to an absolutely free and no expense delivery including C- section.
- All expenses are borne by the government.
- A pregnant woman is also entitled to free transport from home to the government health facility.
- Entitlements include free drugs and consumables, free diagnostic, free blood, free diet up to 3 days for normal delivery and 7 days for C-section.
- Similar entitlements have been put in place for all sick newborns accessing public health institutions for healthcare till 30 days after birth.
- This initiative will also help in reducing maternal and infant mortality and morbidity.
