1) Consider the following statements with respect to Joint Comprehensive Plan of Action (JCPOA)

- 1. It curtailed Iran's uranium enrichment program, and opened up Iran's nuclear facilities to international inspection.
- 2. It is a deal negotiated between Iraq and P5+1 Countries in 2015.
- 3. Following the withdrawal of USA from JCPOA deal, France had also recently withdraws from the agreement.

Answer : a

- Joint Comprehensive Plan of Action (JCPOA) was a deal negotiated between "*Iran* and P5+1 Countries" during the Obama era in 2015.
- P5+1 are the permanent five in UN Security Council (US, UK, France, Russia and China) and Germany.
- The deal curtailed Iran's uranium enrichment program, and opened up Iran's nuclear facilities to international inspection.
- 2) Consider the following statements with respect to World Customs Organization (WCO)

#### Answer:d

- World Customs Organization (WCO), established in 1952 as the Customs Co-operation Council (CCC) is an *independent intergovernmental body* whose mission is to *enhance the effectiveness and efficiency of Customs administrations*.
- WCO is the only international organization with competence in Customs matters and can rightly call itself the voice of the international Customs community.
- 3) International Vesak day was celebrated to commemorate the life events of whom among the following?
  - a. Buddha

- b. Mahavira
- c. Sachin Sanyal
- d. Nizamuddin Auliya

Answer: a

- "Vesak", the Day of the Full Moon in the month of May, is the most sacred day to millions of Buddhists around the world.
- It was on the Day of Vesak two and a half millennia ago, in the year 623 B.C. that the Buddha was born.
- It was also on the Day of Vesak that the Buddha attained enlightenment, and it was on the Day of Vesak that the Buddha in his eightieth year passed away.
- The UN General Assembly recognized internationally the Day of Vesak to acknowledge the contribution that Buddhism.
- 4) CarbFix Project sometimes seen in the news recently is associated with?
  - a. Solidifying CO2
  - b. Advanced Carbon dating
  - c. Natural gas extraction
  - d. Insitu mining of Coal

Answer : a

• The *Carbfix project* at *Iceland's* Hellisheidi plant (the world's largest geothermal facility) sought to *solidify the CO2*.

5) Scientists have recently found a new species of reddish-brown pit viper — a venomous snake with a unique heat-sensing system in which of the following states?

Answer:d

- A team of herpetologists have recently discovered India's fifth brown pit viper (reddish-brown)

   a venomous snake with a *unique heat-sensing system* from a forest in West Kameng district of *Arunachal Pradesh*.
- Arunachal pit viper ( Trimeresurus arunachalensis ) is the second serpent to have been discovered after the non-venomous *Crying keelback* in Arunachal's Lepa-Rada district in 2018.
- The new species also makes Arunachal Pradesh the only Indian state to have a pit viper named after it.

6) Wanchuwa festival is celebrated in which of the following states?

Answer : c

- Wanchuwa festival is celebrated by Tiwa tribesmen of Karbi Anglong district in Assam.
- Tiwas pray for a bountiful harvest and protection from agrarian pests during this festival.

#### Answer : c

- Bentinck engaged in an extensive range of cost-cutting measures through efficient financial management.
- His modernizing projects included a policy of westernization, influenced by the Utilitarianism of Jeremy Bentham and James Mill.
- Reforming the court system, he made English, rather than Persian, the language of the higher courts and encouraged western-style education for Indians to provide more educated Indians for service in the British bureaucracy.
- He abolished the Provincial Courts of Appeal and Circuit and transferred these duties to the magistrates and collectors.
- $\bullet$  William Bentinck has followed the policy of the non-interference in the affairs of the Indian states.
