Answer: d

- The **26th Edition** of **Singapore India** Maritime Bilateral Exercise (SIMBEX) 19 has commenced in the **South China Sea** recently.

- Drug Controller General of India (DGCI) under the gamut of Central Drugs Standard Control Organization, Ministry of Health and Family Welfare is responsible for approval of licenses of specified categories of drugs such as blood and blood products, IV fluids, vaccines and sera in India.
- DCGI lay down the standard and quality of manufacturing, selling, import and distribution of drugs in India.
- It acts as an appellate authority in case of any dispute regarding the quality of drugs.
- It prepares and maintains national reference standard.
- It brings about the uniformity in the enforcement of the Drugs and Cosmetics Act.
- It trains Drug Analysts deputed by State Drug Control Laboratories and other Institutions.

Answer: c

- Part IV of the Constitution (Articles 36-51) contains the Directive Principles of State Policy.
- It shall be the duty of the State to follow these principles both in the matter of administration as well as in the making of the laws.
- They embody the object of the State as 'Welfare State'.
- It aims at establishing the economic and social democracy. Whereas Part III or Fundamental Rights aims at establishing political democracy.
- 5) 'Oru-Jati, Oru-Matam, Oru-Daivam, Oru-Manushyanu' is associated with

Answer: b

- Sahodarn Ayyaippan believed in Jati Venda, Matham Venda, Daivam Venda Manushyanu (**No Caste, No Religion, No God for Human-beings**). Despite such atheism, he nevertheless had deep respect for the Guru.

Answer: c

- Bhitarkanika National Park is a national park located in the Kendrapara District Odisha in eastern India.
- The national park is surrounded by the Bhitarkanika Wildlife Sanctuary. Gahirmatha Beach and Marine Sanctuary lies to the east, and separates swamp region cover with canopy of mangroves from the Bay of Bengal.
- The Bhitarkanika Mangroves cover an area of 650 km2 in the river delta of the Brahmani and Baitarani rivers.

- The Bhitarkanika Mangroves are home to 55 of India's 58 known mangrove species.
- The mangroves harbor one of India's largest populations of saltwater crocodiles, and Gahirmatha Beach, which separates the mangroves from the Bay of Bengal, is the world's most important nesting beach for olive ridley sea turtles.
- 7) Which of the following statement is correct regarding the Primary deficit?

Answer: c

- Primary deficit is one of the parts of fiscal deficit. While fiscal deficit is the difference between total revenue and expenditure, primary deficit can be arrived by deducting interest payment from fiscal deficit.
- Interest payment is the payment that a government makes on its borrowings to the creditors.
- Primary deficit = government spending tax revenues
- Fiscal deficit = primary deficit + interest payments on borrowings.
- 8) What is the scientific reason behind the usage of CO2 to extinguish the fire caused due to electrical or other fire accidents?
 - a. It reduces the heat generation around the accident spot
 - b. CO2 reacts with oxygen thereby reduces the source for the flame
 - c. It is heavier than oxygen and covers fire like a blanket
 - d. The lighter nature of CO2 makes it to act as a catalyst to extinguish the fire

Answer:

- Carbon dioxide extinguishers work because carbon dioxide molecules are heavier than oxygen molecules.
- When the liquid carbon dioxide inside the extinguisher expands into a gas, the carbon dioxide pushes out any oxygen surrounding the fire. Without oxygen available to fuel the chemical reaction, the fire goes out quickly.
- This property can also make them dangerous in confined spaces since the carbon dioxide also pushes out any oxygen that the user needs to breathe.
- 9) The Pelindaba Treaty is related with which of the following?

- African Nuclear Weapon-Free Zone Treaty (ANWFZT) also known as the Treaty of Pelindaba establishes a Nuclear-Weapon-Free Zone in Africa.
