1) With respect to *Foreigners Tribunal*, consider the following statements:

- 1. Foreigners (Tribunals) Order, 1964, is applicable to the whole country and is not specific to any state.
- 2. The powers to constitute such foreigners tribunal were vested only with the Centre.

Which of the statement(s) given above is/are correct?

- a. 1 only
- b. 2 only
- c. Both 1 and 2
- d. Neither 1 nor 2

Answer : a

- The Foreigners (Tribunals) Order, 1964 was issued by the Central Government under Section 3 of The Foreigners Act, 1946.
- It is applicable to the whole country.
- Major amendments in the Foreigners (Tribunals) Order, 1964 were undertaken in 2013.
- The last amendment was issued in May, 2019.
- All these orders are applicable to the whole country and are *not specific to any state*.
- The MHA has recently amended the Foreigners (Tribunals) Order, 1964, and has empowered **district magistrates in all States and Union Territories** to set up tribunals to decide whether a person staying illegally in India is a foreigner or not.
- *Earlier*, the powers to constitute tribunals were vested only with the Centre.
- 2) Consider the following statements with respect to Pradhan mantri Jan Vikas Karykram (PMJVK)
 - 1. It seeks to provide better socio economic infrastructure facilities to the minority communities.
 - 2. The beneficiaries under the scheme include both religious and linguistic minorities.

Answer : a

- **Pradhan mantri Jan Vikas Karykram (PMJVK)** seeks to provide better socio economic infrastructure facilities to the minority communities particularly in the field of education, health & skill development.
- It would further lead to lessening of the gap between the national average and the minority communities with regard to backwardness parameters.
- As far as PMJVK is concerned, the communities notified as minority communities under Section 2 (c) of the National Commission for Minorities Act, 1992 would be taken as Minority

Communities.

• At present 6 (six) communities namely *Muslims, Sikhs, Christians, Buddhists, Zoroastrians (Parsis) and Jains* have been notified as Minority Communities under Section 2 (c) of the National Commission for Minorities Act, 1992.

3) With respect to *Appointments Committee*, consider the following statements

- 1. It decides all higher level appointments in the Central Secretariat, Public Enterprises, Banks and Financial Institutions.
- 2. It will be headed by the Home Minister.

Which of the statement(s) given above is/are correct?

Answer: a

- The following four are the more important cabinet committees:
- 1. The *Political Affairs Committee* deals with all policy matters pertaining to domestic and foreign affairs.
- 2. The *Economic Affairs Committee* directs and coordinates the governmental activities in the economic sphere.
- 3. *Appointments Committee* decides all higher level appointments in the Central Secretariat, Public Enterprises, Banks and Financial Institutions.
- 4. **Parliamentary Affairs Committee** looks after the progress of government business in the Parliament.
- The *first three committees are chaired by the Prime Minister* and the last one by the Home Minister.
- Of all the Cabinet Committees, the most powerful is the *Political Affairs Committee*, often described as a *Super-Cabinet*.

4) Consider the following statements with respect to Defence Space Research Agency (DSRO)

- 1. It has been entrusted with the task of creating space warfare weapon systems and technologies.
- 2. It will provide research and development support to the Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO).

Answer: a

- Prime Minister headed Cabinet Committee on Security (CCS) has recently cleared a proposal to set up a new agency for developing sophisticated weapon systems and technology for space warfare.
- The new agency will be called **Defence Space Research Agency (DSRO)** and will be responsible for creating space warfare weapons systems under the Defence Space Agency (DSA).
- It has been entrusted with the task of creating space warfare weapon systems and technologies.
- The DSRO will be aided by a team of scientists which will work closely with the staff officers of

the integrated tri-services.

• The agency will provide research and development support to the **Defence Space Agency** (**DSA**), created to develop an eco-system to fight wars in space.

5) Consider the following statements with respect to Speaker Pro Tem

- 1. Usually, the senior most member is selected as Speaker Pro Tem.
- 2. The President him/herself administers oath to the Speaker Pro Tem.

Which of the statement(s) given above is/are correct?

- a. 1 only
- b. 2 only
- c. Both 1 and 2
- d. Neither 1 nor 2

Answer : c

- The Speaker of the last Lok Sabha vacates his office immediately before the first meeting of the newly-elected Lok Sabha.
- Therefore, the President appoints a member of the Lok Sabha as the Speaker *Pro Tem*.
- Usually, the *senior most member* is selected for this.
- The **President himself administers oath** to the Speaker Pro Tem.
- The Speaker *Pro Tem* has all the powers of the Speaker.
- He presides over the first sitting of the newly-elected Lok Sabha.
- His main duty is to administer oath to the new members.
- He also enables the House to elect the new Speaker.
- When the new Speaker is elected by the House, the office of the Speaker *Pro Tem* ceases to exist.
- Hence, this office is a temporary office, existing for a few days.
- Recently, Virendra Kumar was appointed as the Pro-tem Speaker of the Lok Sabha.

6) Consider the following statements with respect to Defence Space Agency (DSA)

- 1. It has been created to develop an eco-system to fight wars in space.
- 2. It comprises members from all the three services.

Which of the statement(s) given above is/are correct?

Answer : c

- Defence Space Agency (DSA) was created to develop an eco-system to fight wars in space.
- The DSA comprises members of the *three armed services* the Indian Navy, Air Force and Army.
- It is being set up in Bengaluru under an officer with the rank of air vice-marshal and is set to take over the space related activities of the three services.

7) Consider the following statements with respect to *Binturongs*

- 1. They are nocturnal and sleep during the day high up in the canopy.
- 2. They use its tail as a fifth limb for support when climbing trees and also to hang upside down from branches.
- 3. They were found in South and South East Asia including India.

Which of the statement(s) given above is/are correct?

- a. 2 only
- b. 1 and 2 only
- c. 2 and 3 only
- d. 1, 2 and 3

Answer:d

- Binturongs are *nocturnal and sleep during the day* high up in the canopy.
- It is a mammal found in the rainforest canopy throughout *South and South-East Asia, including in North-Eastern India*.
- They use its tail as a fifth limb for support when climbing trees and also to hang upside down from branches.
- They are carnivores, eating small mammals, birds, fish and fruit.
- Binturongs can swim well and have good eyesight both at night and during the day.
- Binturongs have no known predators other than humans.
- It has been listed as *Vulnerable* under the IUCN Red list.
- 8) Which of the following committees is often described as a "Super Cabinet"?
 - a. The Political Affairs Committee
 - b. The Economic Affairs Committee
 - c. The Appointments Committee
 - d. The Parliamentary Affairs Committee

Answer : a

- Of all the Cabinet Committees, the most powerful is the *Political Affairs Committee*, often described as a *Super-Cabinet*.
- 9) VG Kannan Committee sometimes seen in the news recently was constituted to?
 - a. Increase non-tax revenue
 - b. Review the ATM pricing
 - c. Investigate intra-banking frauds
 - d. Study Western Ghats for neutrino lab
- Answer:b
 - The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) has set up a six-member committee, headed by *VG Kannan*, Chief Executive, Indian Banks' Association, *to review the ATM interchange fee structure*, with a view to giving a fillip to ATM deployment in unbanked areas.
 - The committee will *review existing patterns of costs, charges and interchange fees for ATM transactions*.

10) Which of the following crops can be grown in both kharif and Rabi seasons in India?

- 1. Rice
- 2. Wheat
- 3. Groundnut
- 4. Jowar

Select the correct answer using the code given below:

- a. 1 and 2 only
- b. 2 and 3 only
- c. 1, 3 and 4 only

d. 1, 2, 3 and 4

Answer: c

- Wheat needs 12 to 15 inches (31 to 38 centimeters) of water to produce a good crop.
- It grows best when temperatures are warm, from 70° to 75° F (21° to 24° C), but not too hot.
- Wheat also needs a lot of sunshine, especially when the grains are filling.
