- 1) *U.K.Sinha Committee* sometimes seen in the news recently is constituted for which of the following purposes?
  - a. To review norms pertaining to prevention of insider trading
  - b. To suggest recommendations for fair market conduct
  - c. To review regulations pertaining to Market Infrastructure Institutions
  - d. To review the current framework for the MSME sector

#### Answer: d

- The committee formed by the **Reserve Bank of India (RBI)**, headed by former SEBI Chairman **U.K. Sinha** has submitted its report to the RBI Governor recently.
- It recommends for the creation of a distressed asset fund, with a corpus of Rs. 5,000 crore, structured to assist units in clusters where a change in the external environment, e.g. a ban on plastics or 'dumping' has led to a large number of MSMEs becoming non-performing asset (NPA).
- 2) Food and Nutrition Security Analysis India is a report prepared in collaboration with the Ministry of Statistics and Programme Implementation by which of the following agencies?

# Answer: c

- Food and Nutrition Security Analysis India 2019 was prepared by the UN World Food Programme in collaboration with the Ministry of Statistics and Programme Implementation.
- It is a baseline analysis of the country's progress in achieving the second Sustainable Development Goal to end hunger.
- 3) With respect to the recently released report *Healthy States, Progressive India*, consider the following statements:
  - 1. It has been developed by NITI Aayog, with technical assistance from the World Bank, in consultation with the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare.
  - 2. Kerala and Tamil Nadu are the leading states in the overall performance on health indicators followed by Andhra Pradesh and Maharashtra.
  - 3. Uttar Pradesh scored the lowest and remained as the least ranked state.

Which of the statement(s) given above is/are correct?

#### Answer: c

- **Kerala** continued to **top the list** for the best performing State in the health sector among the 21 large States, while **Uttar Pradesh retained the worst performer tag**, according to the **second edition** of NITI Aayog's *Healthy States*, *Progressive India* report.
- The report has been developed by NITI Aayog, with technical assistance from the **World Bank**, in consultation with the **Ministry of Health and Family Welfare**.
- It has ranking in three categories larger States, smaller States and Union Territories "to ensure comparison among similar entities."
- The Index ranks the States and Union Territories based on 23 health-related indicators, including neonatal mortality rate, under-five mortality rate, proportion of low birth weight among new-borns, proportion of districts with functional Cardiac Care Units, full immunisation coverage and proportion of specialist positions vacant at district hospitals.
- In rankings, **Tamil Nadu has slipped from third place** in 2015-16 to **ninth place** in 2017-18.
- Among the bigger states, Andhra Pradesh gained six ranks (biggest jump) and Tamil Nadu dropped six places (biggest fall).
- 4) Wildlife experts have recently discovered the *Impressed Tortoise* also known as the Manouria impressa in which of the following regions?
  - a. Western Ghats

#### Answer: c

- A team of herpetologists from the Forest Department and two NGOs have recently discovered the *Impressed Tortoise* (Manouria impressa) in Yazali area of the Lower Subansiri district of *Arunachal Pradesh*.
- There are only two species of tortoises under the Manouria genus.
- India was known to be the home of only the Asian Forest Tortoise (Manouria emys) until the discovery of the Impressed Tortoise.
- 5) *Chelonian* is an order of reptile that includes which of the following?
  - 1. Turtles
  - 2. Terrapins
  - 3. Tortoises

# Answer: d

- Chelonian is an order of reptile that includes turtles, terrapins and tortoises.
- 6) Zero Chance Campaign sometimes seen in the news recently is launched by which of the following countries?
  - a. China
  - b. Taiwan
  - c. Ukraine

#### d. Australia

## Answer: d

- The Australian government is launching a campaign 'Zero Chance' to raise awareness among people trying to enter the country illegally by boats.
- The underlying message of Zero Chance campaign is: **Anyone who tries to come illegally to Australia by boat has zero chance of success**.
- Australia has so far turned back 847 people on 35 vessels trying to enter Australia illegally, as part of the *Operation Sovereign Borders* that has been implemented since 2013.
- 7) Antiqua and Barbuda Islands is located in which of the following regions?
  - a. Banda Sea and Arafura Sea
  - b. Caribbean Sea and Atlantic Ocean
  - c. Gulf of Mexico and Pacific Ocean
  - d. Philippine Sea and North Pacific Ocean

# Answer: b

- Antigua and Barbuda Islands is a country located between the Caribbean Sea and the Atlantic Ocean.
- 8) Consider the following statements with respect to Rajya Sabha
  - 1. The seats are allotted to the states in the Rajya Sabha on the basis of population.
  - 2. The president must nominate two members from the Anglo-Indian community in the Rajya Sabha.
  - 3. Union Territories except Delhi and Puducherry were not represented in the Rajya Sabha.

Which of the statement(s) given above is/are correct?

- a. 1 only
- b. 1 and 2 only
- c. 1 and 3 only
- d. 1, 2 and 3

### Answer: c

- The seats are allotted to the states in the Rajya Sabha on *the basis of population*.
- Hence, the number of representatives varies from state to state.
- For example, Uttar Pradesh has 31 members while Tripura has 1 member only.
- Out of the 7 union territories, only 2 (**Delhi and Puducherry**) have representation in Rajya Sabha.
- The populations of other five union territories are too small to have any representative in the Rajya Sabha.
- The President can nominate two members from the Anglo-Indian community, if the community is not adequately represented in the Lok Sabha.
- 9) Consider the following statements:
  - 1. It comprises of growing compatible plants of different heights on the same field at the same time.
  - 2. It is mostly practised in orchards and plantation crops for maximum use of solar energy even under high planting density.

Identify the method of farming that correctly matches with the above description?

- a. Terrace farming

# Answer: b

- The Centre plans to promote multi-layer farming as part of its efforts to help double the income of farmers.
- Multi-layer farming comprises of growing compatible plants of **different heights on the** same field at the same time.
- It is mostly practised in orchards and plantation crops for maximum use of solar energy even under high planting density.
