- Exercise Yudh Abhyas is one of the largest joint running military training and defence

corporation endeavours between India and USA.

• This will be the **15th edition** of the joint exercise hosted **alternately** between the two countries.

3) With respect to *Terracotta Grinder* sometimes seen in the news recently, consider the following statements

- This Terracotta grinder will make grinding of wasted pottery items faster than the traditional mortar and pestle.

- The NDB is *the first Multilateral Development Bank* established by developing countries and emerging economies Brazil, Russia, India, China and South Africa.
- The mandate of the Bank is to mobilize resources for infrastructure and sustainable development projects in **BRICS** and other emerging economies and developing countries, complementing the existing efforts of multilateral and regional financial institutions for global growth and development.
- India is one of the founding members, holding 20% stake in the Bank.
- The Bank is headquartered in *Shanghai, China*.
- 6) Consider the following statements with respect to Project REPLAN
 - 1. It aims to remove the existing waste plastic material from nature and use it in a semi-permanent manner.
 - 2. It was launched by the Ministry of Environment, Forests and Climate Change.

Which of the statement(s) given above is/are correct?

Answer : a

- Project REPLAN was launched by the *Khadi and Village Industries Commission (KVIC)*.
- In this project, the waste plastic is collected, cleaned, chopped, beaten and treated for softness.
- After that, it is mixed with the paper raw material i.e. cotton rags pulp in a ratio of 80 % (pulp) and 20% (plastic waste).
- REPLAN aims to *remove the existing waste plastic* material from nature and *use it in a semi-permanent manner*, so that availability of plastic in nature is reduced to a large extent.



- He was Congress president thrice, in 1886, 1893, and 1906.
- He was among the key proponents of the 'Drain Theory', disseminating it in his 1901 book 'Poverty and Un-British Rule in India'.

9) Travel and Tourism Competitiveness Index was released by which of the following?

Answer:b

- India jumps six ranks to 34 on the world travel and tourism competitiveness index 2019 released by the *World Economic Forum (WEF)*.
- 10) Global Liveability Ranking 2019 Report was recently released by which of the following?

Answer:d

- One of Pakistan's cities Karachi has been ranked among one of the least liveable cities on the earth.
- On the other hand, national capital Delhi does not even feature in the top 100 cities to live in,

according to a recent report by the *Economist Intelligence Unit* titled *Global Liveability Ranking 2019*.

• Karachi got 136th spot out of 140 cities across the world whereas Delhi was on 118th position, slipping six spots from its previous ranking. Syrian city Damascus scored the lowest on the list and was at 140th position.
