India spends 1.5% of gdp to health care
sector and ranks 154 out of 195 countries in
health care accessibility, India have only 0.7
Physician density Per 1,000 Population (who mandate is
1 Per 1000 Population) in terms of hospital bed india
has 0.9 hospital bed at the time WHO requires
1.9 bed Per 1000 Population. Due to this limitations
the tackling of Virus Outbreaks like "novel Corona"
become challenging for india.

The China built a separate hospital section
to days to isolate and treat the Corona
Patients, but in India we only create isolated
wards, these wards itself isolated from
similar wards in rest of india.

→ Medical Research

Due to lack of medical research in virology sector is the major issue. The National Institute of Virology in Pune is the only institute research in this sector. Indian government recent step to establish a virology institute in Kerala on the wake of Nipah Virus Outbreak is welcoming step. But create only after issues is major problem in our health sector.
