


The 14th CoP to the United Nations Convention to Combat Desertification, hosted by India, adopted that land degradation is largely responsible for climate change.

Land degradation led climate change

Effect

- Recent report from 'National Centre for Scientific Research' & 'Atomic Energy Commission' said that global temperature will rise by $6\text{--}7^{\circ}\text{C}$ by 2100.
- IPCC report: This will lead to ocean acidification, affecting climate pattern (El Nino, La Nina effect) which in turn causes floods & droughts frequently.
- It does not stop there, also causes food security \rightarrow lead to loss of lives \rightarrow lead to loss of economy \rightarrow unstability in the world

Way forward:

- Stop mindless & dangerous construction projects in danger zone.
- Use the fund of Land Degradation Neutrality (LDN) launched in 13th COP, UNCCD for restoration & rehabilitation of land.
- Changing our consumption pattern to not affect the economy as well as overburden the land.
