

1a. Proactive Involvement of state governments
Possible way to combat Maoist insurgency in country. Analyse (see)

The Ongoing Narrative - Maoist insurgency conflict in the present form began after formation Communist Party of India (Maoist) and a rebel group composed of People's War Group. Maoist Communist Party in 2004. Maoist ^{attack} Government for demand of the proper land acquisition and release of prisoners and redistribution of land. Conflict takes place in large part of the country.

During 2009 Internal Action Plan attack taken by India Government along - Andhra Pradesh (55% of Maoist), Karnataka, Maharashtra, Chattisgarh, Orissa, West Bengal, Jharkhand, Bihar and Uttar Pradesh.
→ With in one full year Karnataka has been removed from the list as it remove Maoist group from the major district.
→ After 2009 - Maoist attack has decreased to 50%.

Proactive Involvement

- setting up large police camp to monitor the internal security and deploy large resources and use of advance technology like satellite to monitor status.
- Create the economic stability from grass root level. like building Primary school and health care and basic job facility and skill development program.
- Mosty Poor Villages and tribe become the target for recruitment to reduce this - Create awareness and Create Proper Interaction between Government and Poor Villages and tribe. - this is one of positive action which suppressed the new recruitment.
- Strict monitoring of illegal mining and resource rich area. where most of Maoist attack took place.
- In recent Chattisgarh is face lot of Maoist attack - which is under, strengther training and capacity of and provide financial support to strengther training of specialised wings.
