Geographical factors:-

Fund Related issues:-

Due to the finance is being underfunded to some SPCB they have to depend on fund from "No Objection Certificate" or consent certificate. Stable fund should be provided through budgetary mechanisms.

Governance related issues:-

Air pollution is from several sources such as stubble burning, transport, indoor air pollution, industries etc. So every state boards should be provided with specialised technical infrastructure, staffs, adequate legal staffs, and with adequate funding mechanism.

State Pollution control boards should be given adequate autonomy on making policies, technical and physical infrastructure with overmonitoring coordination of central boards.
