For facilitating expansive, efficient, and extended health administration services, 'health' comes under State List (Schedule 7) of Indian Constitution. However, during second wave of COVID-19 (April 2021):-

- Lack of medical oxygen supply to citizens and hospitals
- Reduced availability of essential medical equipments and medicines
- Overcrowding of hospital beds
- Fatalities due to all these might indicate need for All India National Health Services, replicating its operational model like British National Health Services for centralised health facilities

Yet, "more than service facility, SERVICE DELIVERY is essential". Be it, centralised or decentralised.

Benefit of decentralised health services, were seen when some states could provide surplus of medical oxygen to states in need. Example: Chhattisgarh helped its neighbouring state Andhra Pradesh with medical oxygen once -


