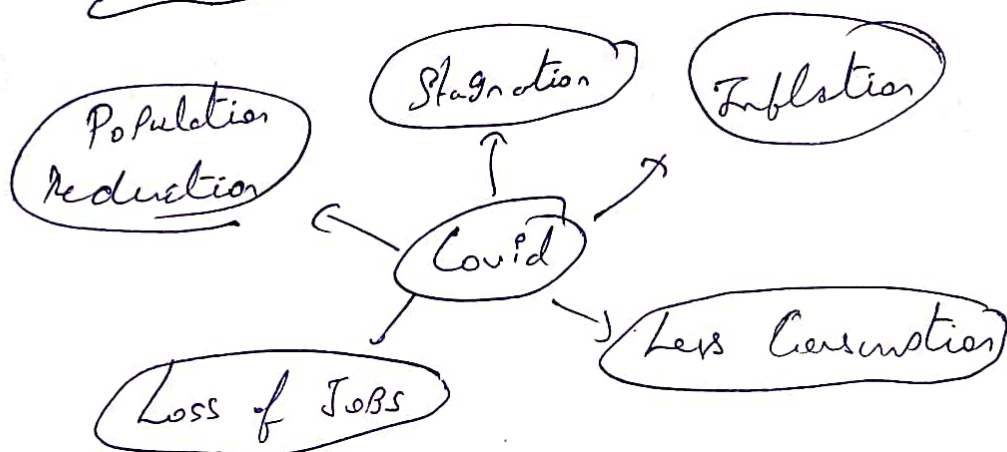


2. The impact of Agriculture climate related food shortages could be more dangerous than that of the Covid 19 Pandemic. Do you agree with this view? Comment. (100 words)
