What are the lessons that India should learn from recent standoff which occurred in Taiwan? Elaborate

The recent visit of US speaker to Taiwan has urged China causing it to perform military drills along Taiwan. There are numerous takeaways from the standoff for India.

Lessons from the Taiwan Standoff

- ① Sovereignty → Though Taiwan is not independent from China, it stands up for its sovereignty. The stand off at line of actual control was lately recognised by India.
China has illegally occupied more than 30,000 km² of land in Ladakh region yet India respects China's one China policy even it has occupied land proportions to the size of Kerala.

Even China blocked the designation of Ashgar
and Makki as global terrorist in UNSC
1267 committee.

② Taiwan is the largest supplier
of semiconductor to China, yet it permitted
Pele's visit knowing the ramifications of
the decision. India has trade deficit of
\$73 Billion with China, but this must not
stop India from securing its territorial
space. The appeasement strategy must not
be the answer.

With the initiation of Quad and
initiatives such as PGII - Partnership group
for infrastructure and investment. India has
the barriers towards unilateral motives of
China.
