Freebies - collapses growth

freebies create macroeconomic instability as it drags the states to debt. Punjab debt to GSDP ratio is 53%. Andhra Pradesh spends 13% of its revenue on its first payments.

free water and electricity to farmers endangers water security. The groundwater level has plummeted in Punjab, Haryana and Maharashtra due to free electricity. The subsidised power, and fertiliser are diverted for non agricultural use underwriting the rural inequality.

However - as per the world inequality report, India's top 1% own 51% of wealth and bottom 60% have 5% of the wealth stressing to give freebies.

freebies - Ensures welfare state

Employment is guaranteed for the poor people by the MGNREGA which has been proposed to increase by 150 days.

Health is ensured through the midday meal scheme which has increased enrolment in schools.

Nutrition: The PM midday meal Yojana fed more than 80 crore people during the pandemic.
