With respect to G20 presidency, India can learn a lot from Indonesia's achievements. Elaborate

India is in the Track of G20 and will set to take the presidency of the forum. India is followed by Brazil and South Africa in presidency developing south-south co-operation.

The G20 represents 65% of world population, 75% of global trade and 85% of global GDP. The measures of Indonesia can be a lesson to us.

Lessons from Indonesia and India's outreach

① Engagement in multilateral blocks Indonesia participates in regional trade blocks and economic co-operation such as RCEP and APEC - Asia Pacific Economic Co-operation.

② India's success is largely benefited from engagement with Australia in education and Japan in investment which boosted Indian role in global supply chain.

③ Think 20 / T-20 summit. The idea bank of G20 enables the G20 policymakers to engage in pooled resources of education and research to solve global problems.
