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Critically examine the challenges of 'Namami Ganga' Mission - India's Most ambitious endeavour

1) Funds:

The total funds allocated for the National Mission on clean Ganga is under utilized because of non finalization of action plan by the authority.

2) Toilets:

Out of 5 states through which Ganga flows only Uttarakhand has achieved open defecation free status and utilized 100% of the funds allocated for building toilets in every household.

3) Sewage:

There is no proper maintenance of Sewage pipeline and which resulted in continuous pollution of the Ganga River

4) Waste Management:

Non Separation of Solid ~~waste~~ biodegradable and non degradable waste at source is also causing a problem in this regard.

5) Pollution:

In overall context the rate at which the Ganga is cleaned is much less than the rate at which it is polluted.

6) Technology :

There is a lack of research and development and lack of technology helpful for Identifying river conservation zones and devising Mechanism for Sustainable development.

MEASURES TO BE TAKEN :

- 1) Proper utilization of funds and Implementation of schemes
- 2) Mass awareness & encouraging of people to have toilets at every household level.
- 3) Regular monitoring of projects
- 4) Legal action against the deterrents including the government officials.
- 5) Increasing the available number of Sewage treatment plants & toilets.
