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The earth had passed from a warming phase into an era of global boiling. Era of global ~~warming~~ ^{Boiling}

The term 'Global Boiling' refers to an increased amount of greenhouse gases in the atmosphere results in the increasing the temperature and causes extreme weather conditions.

1.5°C global temperature:

To avoid the worst of climate change, the countries fixed the target of not to rise the global temperature more than 1.5°C .

Not possible to achieve the target:

The baseline ~~average~~ of CO_2 emissions is 2.3 tonnes per capita to achieve the limit of global temperature 1.5°C .

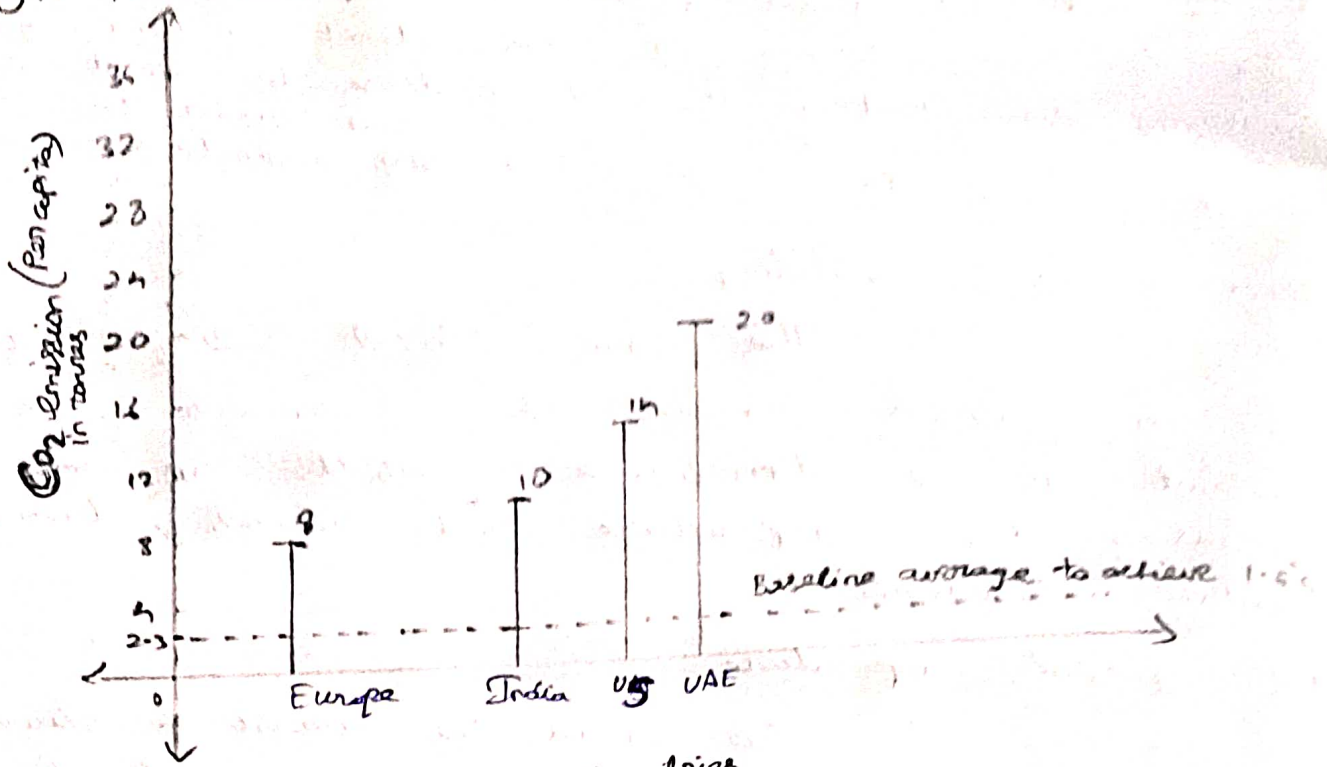
At present, the global average CO_2 emission is 4.7 tonnes per capita. More than that, in India

the average CO_2 emission is 10 tonnes per capita (approximately).

US and UAE records the highest amount of CO_2 emissions, i.e. 14 tonnes and 21 tonnes per capita respectively (approx.).

Things to do to achieve the target:

1) Reduce the use of fossil fuels:

The world should come forward to reduce the use of fossil fuels which emit more CO₂ to the atmosphere.

2) Convert to Renewable:

The countries should think forward to avoid the use of non-renewable resources and convert into the use of Renewable.

3) Allot more funding to climate change:

many developed countries still not allot more funding to climate change. (US allot 0.3-1% of GDP to climate). It should be address to poor and Developing countries.

4) Distribute fund to poor and Developing countries:

It is said that the poor countries that cannot afford to the climate related factors are more vulnerable to climate change. So, it is indispensable to allocate more fund to the poor & developing countries.
