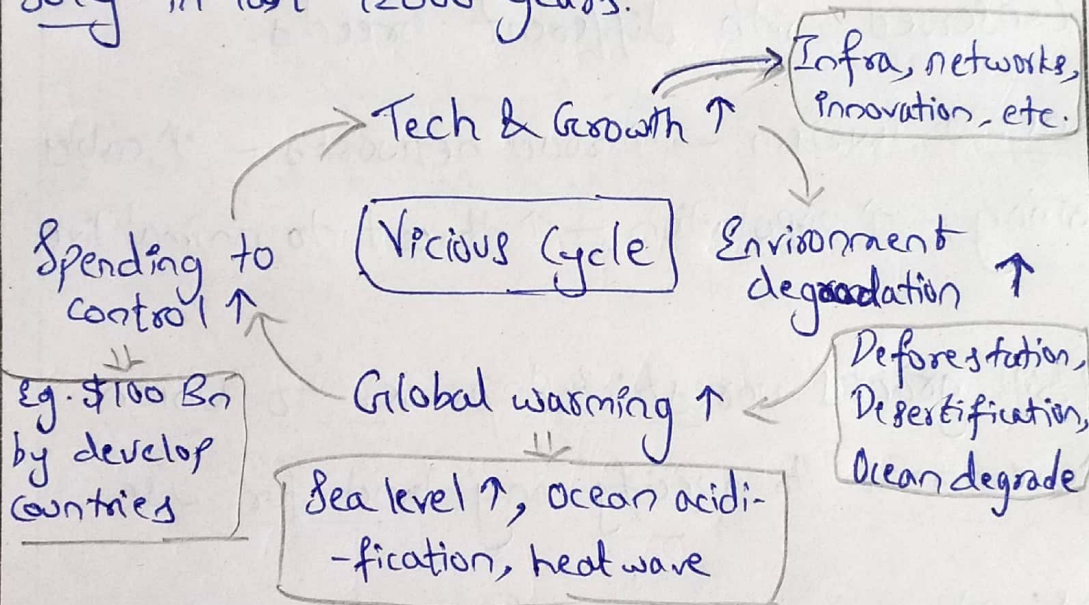

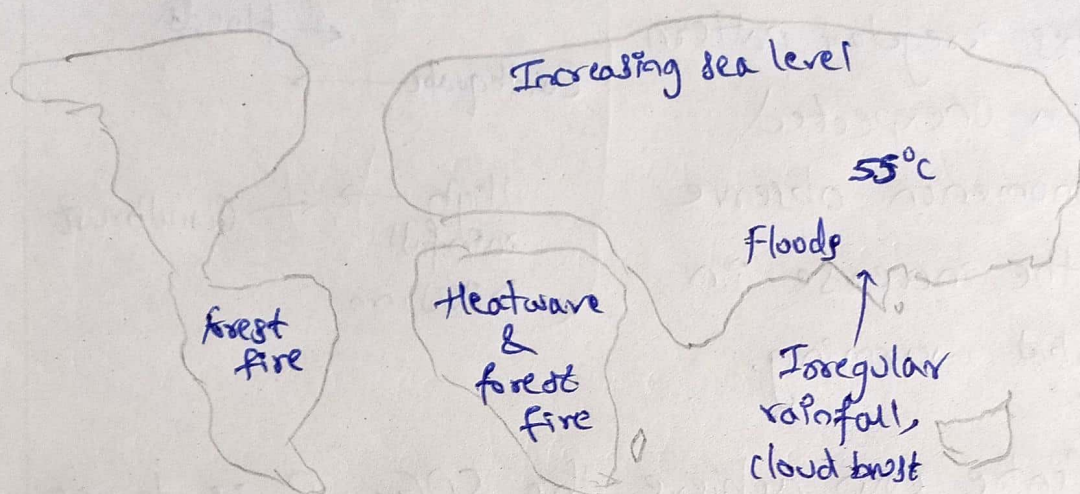
Recently, Earth has passed through a phase of "Era of Boiling" - Recording hottest month July in last 12000 years.



⇒ According to Paris Agreement, 2015 ⇒ countries should maintain their pre-industrial pollution level under 2°C ; if possible 1.5°C .

⇒ India, also committed to a goal of net zero by 2070.

⇒ Issues at International level:



→ At present, it seems to be seen difficult in achieving 1.5°C level but world need to start preparing with immediate action to make it under control.

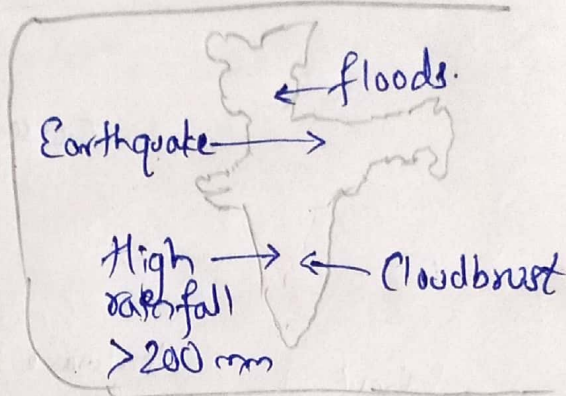
→ As per WHO report, world has seen an average of 16.2°C in month July which is a record of the highest ever.

→ Ways can be managed by world:

- 1) Trading without disrupted environment.
- 2) Helping developing/under-develop countries with their goals with growth.

⇒ Issues at National level:
