In WTO's Agreement of Agriculture (AoA) there are certain rules to maintain fair subsidy to agriculture for fair food trade practice.

e.g. for India 10% of production value can only be issued as subsidy.

→ Beyond this limits there will be counter-veiling duty imposed on the products this will demotivate the farmers & the government on

Uplifting Agriculture.

- The WTO still follows a 2 decade old Rules which makes little sense in present
- Many Least Developed Country (LDC) & developing country are being crippled by these rules in promoting Agriculture.
- With Public stockholding (PSH) being locked away from trade further adds fueling the ongoing food crisis.

With the Relaxation on the Rules on Agricultural Subsidy & Prudent allocation of limits of Subsidy on country to country will help to the country & to achieve SDG 2 - Eliminate Hunger world wide.
