3) NIRF (National Institutional Ranking Framework)

It evaluates each higher education institution and brings in more confidence in institution for participating in world rankings.

4) SWAYAM

It is a web portal where massive open on-line courses (MOOCs) will be available on all kinds of subjects up to the ~~level~~ level.

5) Saksham Scholarship Scheme:

It is being implemented by AICTE to provide support to differently abled
