- ④ steps to raise oilseeds output through area expansion & improved productivity in the country must be accompanied by import curbs. Discuss.

India has been imposing 2/3rd of its annual consumption of vegetable oil despite of large geographical area best suited for oil seed production.

In order to increase domestic oil production Government come up with policy measures like increase MSP through PM-ASHA scheme, ensuring area expansion, diversifying raw material for oil product.

However this seems to be short term approach, because decrease in domestic oil production mainly attributed to liberal import policy towards oil seed sector. over last 20 years Unrestricted imports of edible oil-finished or semi finished products have hurt domestic producers, growers, etc,

Thus we need an approach that  
once encourage domestic product  
while discouraging imports, in following  
ways

- \* Review of extent of import policy &  
tariff structure
- \* Placing an annual ceiling on edible  
oil import
- \* Closely monitoring imports by mandating  
a system of contract registration &  
tracking physical arrivals
- \* Long credit period currently enjoyed  
by importers should be restricted to  
30 days

This import restriction will shortly  
push domestic oil seed prices  
& provide much needed boost to  
growers with multiple benefits.

### Way forward

- \* Commerce ministry should initiate  
"zero-import of edible oil" & restrict volume  
of import
- \* Finance ministry must proactively  
change custom duty & not succumb  
to lobby pressure
