Differences in prosperity across Nations:

1. Nations across globe are divided into

- Developed (European, N. American Nations)
- Developing (Asian, S. American Nations).
- Least developed (African nations, certain island nations)

2. The prosperity is classified on the basis of
1. Lack of science & technology knowledge
 2. Promotion of economic knowledge
 3. Resource exploitation knowledge
 4. Ancient history of civilisation knowledge
 5. Emotional knowledge
 6. Cultural knowledge of nations

1. Science & Technology Knowledge:
 1. Innovation Index shows top countries with potential growth than vice versa.
 2. Promotion of technology promotes prosperity
 3. (e.g) W. Asia countries has least technology and low prosperity in diversity than Japan, China, Korea.

2. Economic knowledge:
 1. Ease of doing business - World Bank shows island states to have good prosperity than African states.

2. Promoting knowledge on economy favours growth of nation (e.g) America, Europe

3. Resource Exploitation knowledge:

1. World Economic Outlook - IMF shows China to be far better in prosperity than major Asian states

2. Resource knowledge gives good economic prosperity

4. Ancient Civilisation knowledge:

1. African nations lacks its civilisation knowledge leading to suppression in Past

2. India's prosperity thus due to its ancient prosperity in civilisation knowledge.
