Importance of signing the agreement:

1. National security ÷ Territorial data:
 1. India and USA now gain advantage over China's aggression in Indo-Pacifi
 2. Border Tension in Ladakh can be gained to our hands through USA's technology.
 3. (e.g) Co-ordinates of enemy tanks and bunkers are now shared between USA, India
2. Aeronautical data shared:
 1. This focus towards aeronautical data of fighter jets, anti-satellite missiles
 2. Thus outfow between USA, India gain mutual importance over Russia, China.
3. Nautical data shared:
 1. Submarine, Mines and Navy ships of enemy states in Indo-Pacifi are shared with India
 2. Successful to counter their advantage over Indian Ocean
 3. USA will get freedom of Navigation benefitted
