Discuss <u>advantages</u> &amp; <u>disadvantages</u> of proxy Voting. what other Viable <u>alternatives</u> do you suggest.</p> <p><b>ADVANTAGES :</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1) It will enable the <u>Country</u> to provide Voting rights to NRIs which are enshrined under Article 326</li> <li>2) There are nearly 16 million Indian citizens living abroad and the additional Votes casted by them would play a crucial role in State and Central elections.</li> <li>3) It removes the unreasonable restriction on overseas electors to be <u>physically</u> present in their Constituencies to cast their Votes.</li> <li>4) It will improve the knowledge of external voters on domestic conditions.</li> </ol> <p><b>DISADVANTAGES :</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1) It cannot be guaranteed that proxy Voter will vote as per the wishes of the actual Voter.</li> <li>2) No check on coercion or inducements by the employer to the NRI to exercise their free and fair Voting.</li> <li>3) Practical challenge of confirming NRI Voters before election.</li> </ol>	<p>उन्नीसवारों को इत्त हासिए में नहीं सिर्फ बाहिर</p>
