⑤ These relations further fortified with robust network of military dialogues and regularly held joint exercises Varuna (navy), Bravada (Air force) and Shakti (Army).

⑥ France was among the first country with which India signed Civil Nuclear deal. France supports India's bid for permanent membership in United Nations Security Council and as well as entry of Nuclear Suppliers Group.

⑦ These two countries formed a trilateral grouping with United Arab Emirates to ensure maritime domain awareness and security.

⑧ While there are divergence over the Ukraine crisis, both countries are working together to coordinate on playing a constructive role in the crisis.

⑨ These countries PMs have maintained open communication channel with Russian president and also Ukraine's president.

⑩ Both countries share concerns over the rise of china and its behaviour regionally and globally.

⑪ They are committed to working together to ensure that there is no impar balance in the Indo-pacific. and New forging ahead with cooperation in issues such as digitisation, cyber, green energy, a blue economy, ocean science and space.
