Q5-2 - Government policies

1. Government must prioritise human development alongside economic growth to ensure that the benefits of growth are more evenly distributed. Comment.

Human development is the process of enlarging people's freedoms & opportunities and improving their well-being.
India and Human development.

India - currently 5th Largest economy and fastest growing economy in the world. But the question is whether Economic growth has translated into improving human development?

Human development Index - 'The Answer'

Human development Index → by United Nations Development program → 2021-22 lists India at 132 / 191 countries, behind Bangladesh (129) and Sri Lanka (73).

This shows evidence of lack of translation of economic growth.

Need - for Sub-national Index

Experts suggests - Sub-national Index, to identify areas of High ^{de} growth & low developed areas

for a targeted approach.

Indicators

Life expectancy → data from sample Registration Survey

Schooling → data from national family health survey-5

Standard of living - Gross state domestic product per capita.

Findings -

1. Delhi → held the top spot in Human development
2. whereas - Bihar the bottom spot. [But not in Low but medium human development category]
3. Flip Side High per capita income states like Gujarat & haryana - failed to translate growth into human development.

Reasons

1. Unequal growth - 70% of population holding 77% wealth
2. Social infrastructure → Education, healthcare - quality of services is poor

Way forward

Multipronged approach is needed from Government
Balance between economic growth & welfare to human development, by addressing factors like income, gender inequality etc. is need of hour
