1. Analyse the centre's suggestions on changes in Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme.

Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme is a social security scheme, providing at least 100 days of unskilled work per household in rural areas.

Importance of the Scheme

Scheme → Life line for farmers during lean agri period - wage employment, ensure food security, way to alleviate poverty; Entitles Right to work; Even during pandemic, ~~there~~ it acted as a source/lifeline for urban migrants.

Issues with the Scheme

1. Budget allocation . decreasing year on year
2022-23 ⇒ ₹ 89000 cr → 2023-24 ⇒ ₹ 60,000 cr (there is 33% decrease in funding)

2. wage payment delays . It is seen that with Aadhaar enabled payment system neither reduce wage delays nor corruption.

Changes proposed

Ministry of Rural development proposed change in funding pattern

current	proposed
100:1.	to 60:40
(central sector scheme)	centrally sponsored scheme

with main aim \rightarrow control menace of corruption.

Criticisms

1. Already states revenue has been affected due to pandemic.
2. Goods & Services tax - has leverage center's taxation power; while states are being compensated for loss of revenue, the compensation cess has not been extended after 2022.
3. Since it is a demand driven scheme, poorer states may need more revenue due to more demand, posing additional burden on state.

Way forward

The ~~scheme~~ Best practice like Rajasthan even provides urban guarantee scheme. Center must to undertake adequate study on financial health of state before making any such amendment & also ensure Right touch.
