

[GS-2] - Government policies.

2. There is a need to bring effective tourist police in the country. DO you agree with this view? Comment:

Few days ago, '2' rape convicts were sentenced to life imprisonment for raping & murdering a Lakshmi woman in 2018. This is only 1 example of rising crimes against tourists in India.

Crimes against Foreigners :-

Crimes are rising, but reporting has declined mainly due to 'fear factor'. National Crime Records Bureau data shows - e.g.: Crime cases in Delhi ^{reporting} → declined from (against foreigners) [62 to 23]

In last '3' years, 29 foreigners, has been murdered.

Impact:

1. Crimes against foreigners will seriously dent the image of India globally.

2. Directly impact the foreign exchange reserves as tourism sector is foreign exchange earner.

2019 = \$30 bn \Rightarrow force was earned; 2020 due to COVID - \$6.5 bn & increased only marginally to \$8.7 bn in 2021.

Measures taken.

1. M/o Tourism Bureau of Police Research & Development in conference - come out with 'uniform tourist police scheme' to sensitise crimes against foreigners & for protection to them.

Currently \rightarrow States - U.P, M.P, Ardhya etc. have such scheme.

2. G20 Initiative - there will be huge influx of tourists. i) currently booklet has been prepared regarding preparedness for the scheme $\begin{cases} \text{uniform} \\ \text{police stations} \\ \text{recruitment etc.} \end{cases}$.
ii) 30% - deputation allowance - for tourist policing
What further is needed?

1. Major common crime - is theft \rightarrow hence. Constant surveillance of thieves in around tourist spot

2. Fast track court e.g. Rape convict Mohanty was given 7 year imprisonment within 22 day trial. Such fast disposal of cases, needs to be priority.

Such measures has to be implemented at pan India Level, to ensure justice to foreigners
