3. Explain the special responsibilities of the governor with respect to formation of new state in northern Karnataka.

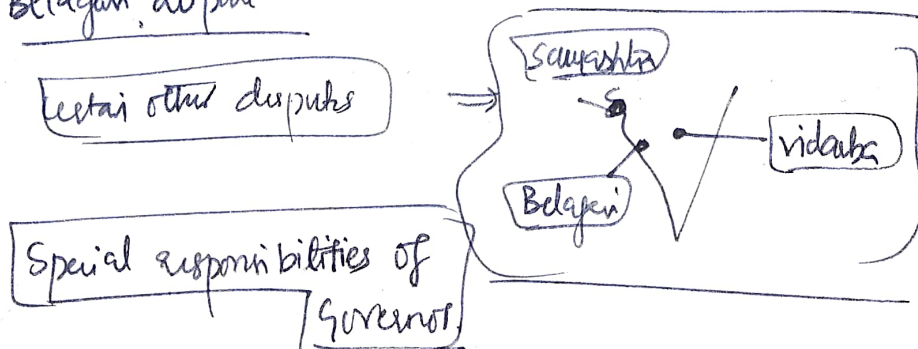
Article '3' of the Indian constitution provides for formation / alteration of states in number of ways.

Formation of new state of northern Karnataka is case of separating a new territory out of existing state.

Reasons for Formation of new states:

1. Most of the state formation based on linguistic ~~formed~~ basis of State Reorganisation Act, 1956.

2. Majority speaking - Marathi speaking and Kannada speaking. This factor on linguistic relation was not taken due care during state formation - led to today's Belagani dispute.



1. Art 159 provides for creation of office of Governor

For administration of state affairs

2. New state formation → under Article 213 Governor can promulgate ordinance for the establishment of new state

3. Since the state has been newly formed, the Governor can act as the head of the state, until new chief minister of the state is elected and appointed by him

4. Language of the state high court (newly formed) can be requested by the Governor.

18. Way forward -

Governor's responsibilities in formation of new states; is crucial, to maintain the administration and ^{maintain} existence of newly ^{formed} state.
