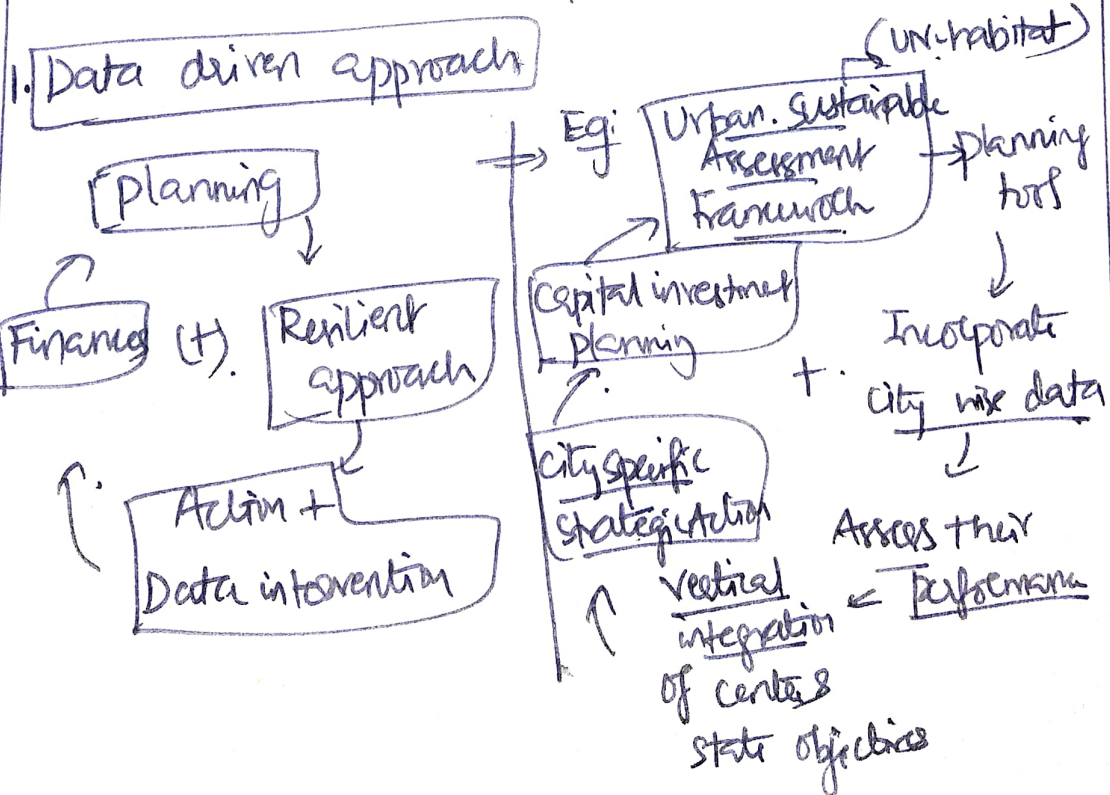

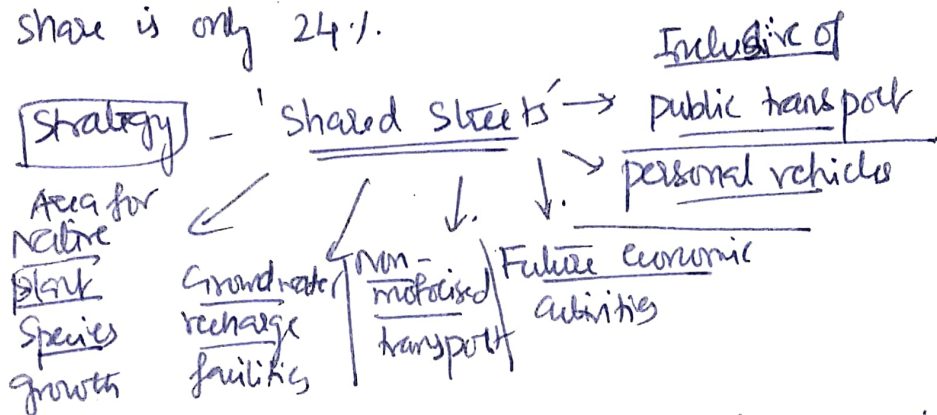
climate resilient urbanization → central point for

2. Case of Bhopal

19% of total Greenhouse emission; non-motorised transport share is 43%; but public vehicle docks/stops share is only 24%.



Strategy will be inclusive and also sustainable. It is expected to reduce Emission by 15+CO₂ per annum per kilometers
