5. Discuss about wet leasing of aircraft for which the ministry of civil aviation has relaxed rules on it.

In order to boost the international travel and revenue, ministry of civil aviation has allowed airlines to procure wide bodied airplanes and extended the wet leasing of aircraft.

Extension.

wetleasing was extended from 6 months to 1 year.

what is wetleasing?

wetleasing is a renting of airplane, crew and engineers, while dryleasing involves renting of only airplanes.

OAG, global airtravel update - describes wetleasing as ACMI - Aircraft, Crew, Maintenance, Insurance still the airline client will bear the direct operating costs like fuel, canteen, ground charges and navigation fee etc.

wetleasing of aircraft is difficult to monitor by Director general of civil aviation. Hence.
