What are the salient features of PM Vishwakarma Scheme? To what extent, it addresses the fundamental problem of traditional craftspeople and artisans?

The Cabinet Committee on Economic Affairs has approved a new central sector scheme

"PM Vishwakarma".

- Financial outlay 13000 crore
- For the duration of 5 yrs.
- Nurture Guru-Shishya parampara.
- Credit support @ rate 5%.
- 18 Traditional trades covered
- Skill devt, Technological upgradation; Tools incentive etc.

Problems of Traditional Craftspeople:

- (1) The major problem they were facing was financial investment to build their market. Hence, with PM Vishwakarma the Govt will provide them support.
- (2) As they were small craftsmen hence no credit by banks were provided to them which led them to buy money from money lender at very high Rate.
- (3) The traditional craftsmen and artisans were vanishing in India; hence a huge loss to small MSME and traditional art and culture of India.
- (4) Technology and skill development was major challenge associated with them. Hence,

WAY FORWARD:

- ① With the initiation of this PM Vishwakarma scheme, the employment might increase.
