In broader terms the rohingya
housing issue seems to be example of clash b/w
Modi govt's foreign policy commitments and its
domestic politics. Although india has
"respected and followed" the 1951 UN convention of refugees
it is not a signatory.

But admit that frequently disregards
the Convention referring to migrants as "termites".
Stating in Parliament that india would never
accept "rohingya" and even violating UN principle
of non repudiation by deporting rohingya women to myanmar
this.

Treatment of rohingya who fled to
india in 2012 & 2017 after State sponsored ethnic
cleaning has also been for former govt's slogan
of "vasudhaiva kutubakam".

Rohingya's has been driven
out of homes in rajasthan & haryana by
local authorities and intelligence agencies who
accuse them for criminal and terrorist intent.

Conclusion:

India govt should play a role as "regional leader" in bringing myanmar to provide its citizens home and ensuring safety.
