

Q. Do you think that the Shanghai Cooperation Organization can stabilize the uncertainties in Afghanistan? Comment.

Ans. Most of the country around the Afghanistan are concerned about the security threats, but some of the SCO countries are also helping Taliban to make their power in the country.

Important points regarding uncertainties of Afghanistan :-

(i) "The SCO member commitment to help Afghanistan build a peaceful, stable and prosperous country free from terrorism, warfare and drugs."

(ii) They called for ensuring the security of Afghanistan's population and foreign nationals staying in that country, missions of foreign states and international organizations.

(iii) The SCO member nations expressed their readiness to take part in international effort toward Afghanistan's stabilization and development, with the United Nations playing the central coordinating role.

(iv) To be sure, the crisis in Afghanistan

presents a major opportunity for the SCO to realise its regional ambitions.

(vi) All we know that dispute between India and Pakistan are problems for both but both countries are now joined SCO in 2017.

(vii) Pakistan, China and Russia are openly support the Taliban to make protection Afghanistan and China recently given some aid to Taliban.

(viii) Pakistan terror group are today also engaged with Taliban and all the major terrorist organisations are working together.

(ix) China and India having also border dispute, but also they are part of the SCO and BRICS like group so have Russia non plans for the so called "strategic-triangle" with China and India.

(x) The central Asian members of the SCO have quarrels of their own, and have struggled to develop collective approaches to their common regional security challenges.

In the end we can say SCO should pressurise on Taliban and Pakistan to hold their promises seriously and effectively.
