

Explain sig. of Sch V & VI in protecting interest & rights of tribals
in light of constitutional provisions.

The Article 244 in Part IX of the
constitution deals with scheduled areas and
tribal areas for protection of the unity
of the tribals.

The protection is guaranteed through
Schedule V and Schedule VI of the
constitution for ten states for the former
and four states for the latter.

Significance of Schedule 5 and 6

Law making can be done for the
betterment of the tribals by the
Autonomous District Councils of the
schedule 6 areas

The Tribal Advisory Council of the schedule 5 areas also regulate the laws.

Regulation and application of the central and state laws is being done by the governors of the state in order to prevent the land alienation by securing the distributive justice of the tribals.

Mainstream the tribal areas and people with national development as they are backward historically due to remoteness and cultural difference.

The Schedule 5 and 6 of the constitution was inserted to protect the rights and interests of tribals in land, habitat among others. It has brought changes in laws of millions.
