



Transparency and accountability is core aspect in transforming governance system of the country. Enamine

CYCLE OF GOOD GOVERNANCE

Good governance is felt through working of legislative, executive, judicial organs of system.



1) Better performance of the government agenda:-

→ Accountability of executive organs to the elected representatives and mandates pushes for best performance method.

example:- 'NITI AAYOG', a government thinktank promoting 'bottom up' model of development, knowledge sharing between states

→ Transparency factor gives credibility to any process, that push participation

example:- Re-counting, introduction of VVPAT ushered in a transparent election commission. voters turnout also increased.

2) Identify deficiencies in administrative system:-

→ goal of administrative system is to serve the people. It is often marred by nepotism, corruption, discriminations.

→ Transparency through legislative mandates helps unearth such issues.

examples:- enactment of Lokpal, Lokayukta Act brings higher echelons under scrutiny

→ Right to Information Act 2005 has been the real enabler for extracting government information, holding them accountable.

example:- RTI pushed 26 scam into limelight

→ In this way common citizen became more associated with government.

3) Efficient Resource handling:-

→ Government's expenditure, revenue / taxation is filled with complexities. system of open budget cleared the air.

→ Tracking of expenditure for implementing various schemes, prevented any false allocations, lapses

examples:- Regular updation of MANRENT portal, ~~etc~~ gave clear cut job and sal income allocation.

enrollment in EPFO was indication of actual GST net of taxation helping informal, formal sector identification. This pushed government to launch calculator, PM laghu vyapan Maandhan Yojana

4) Evolution of digitisation in administration:-

→ Digitisation gave rise to door step delivery of services. It gave the media, the role of 4th estate of government.

example:- e-Courts, live streaming of parliamentary procedures help track government records

→ As a result, inclusiveness was promoted. eg:- social audit, e-governance portal.

→ Jan Soochna Portal by Rajasthan government is 1st such step by any state to lead in transparent service information and accountability through RTI.
