

As the gravity is shifting towards Indo-pacific, India can collaborate with Atlantic powers that is Europe to balance Chinese threat in the region.

North Atlantic Treaty Organisation (NATO)'s last year report accepted China as a potential threat, similarly Chinese expansionist policy in the region specially in Ladakh, is paving the way for Indo-europe cooperation.

and EU have consistent approach of safeguarding
human rights.

ASSOCIATION.

Challenges and way forward

(i) Land border - only India shares land borders with China, and had to adopt more sensitive non aggressive Indo Pacific policy.

(ii) Economic dependence - European countries like Italy, Greece heavily depend on China, and most of them are members of BRI.
→ for this QUAD can be expanded to

include France.
→ malabar exercise should also include major players of Europe.

(iii) Russia factor - Being a trusted ally of India's and Europe, Russia is against Indo Pacific policy. India has to make more ~~diplomatic efforts~~ to neutralise Russia.

thus, for peace, security, democracy and prosperity India & EU can coordinate for free & fair Indo Pacific region.
