Explain the various Strategies that are required to expand the total forest cover of the country. (250 words)

The 'Forest Cover' refers to a land having a minimum area of 1 ha with a tree canopy density of more than 10%. (definition in sync with Kyoto Protocol.)

Strategies to expand total forest cover:-

As per the Indian State of Forest report 2021, the forest and tree cover rose by 2,261 (km)² compared to 2019.

Some of the strategies to improve are as follows :→

→ Tiger/Lion reserves and Corridors with impetus given to the "Tx2" campaign, natural habitats of tiger and lions has encouraged in expansion of the protected forest area.

Thus, conservation of tigers and other animals will go a long way in this ecological protection campaign.

→ Plantations & Bamboo cover

With a rise of climate change uncertainties, Plantations such as cashew, coconut have become vital in protecting coastlines.

Increased cyclones causing severe destruction on both western & eastern coast must be protected with mixed plantations.

For eg:- Native species mixed with ecological functional species.

→ Improving data collection :-

The assessment of forest cover is based on Satellite data.

The accuracy of this segregation of forest and non-forest area is roughly 93% to 96%.

Also, this satellite based data is corroborated from estimated field inventory data.

Hence the improved quality of data, better interpretation, extensive ground area corrections will help in giving a clearer picture of forest area in country.

Emphasis on increasing Trees outside Forest (or TDF)

Incentivising and promoting agroforestry and farm forestry

> Expanding Urban green spaces.

Example → Najar-Van scheme,

Miyawaki forest technique.

> Community partnerships.
