COVID-19 Pandemic has exposed how vulnerable the migrant workers are.

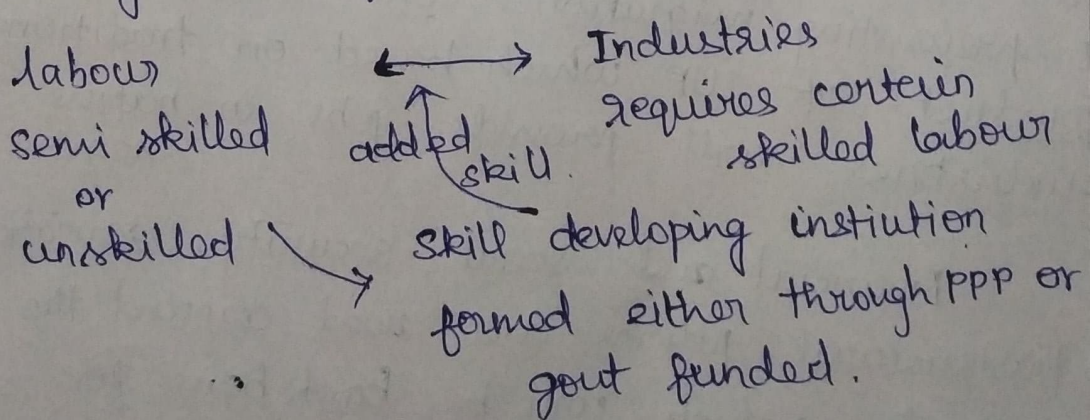
Need for Improvement is evident.

1. creating labour database:

2. Skill development: connecting labour - industry (linkages)



### 3. Educational rework modification:

The syllabus and style of education for colleges & courses based on manufacturing sectors need to modify themselves for emerging needs of Industry.

4. Private partnership: Government policy need to be synced with employers to provide affordable rental housing for migrant (PM Awas Yojana can be roped in)

5. Financial setup: linking of Pradhan Mantri Shram Yogi Yojana with proposed labour database will widen the coverage & awareness.

6. Social security: One nation One ration Scheme which provides interoperability of ration services will be huge positive for labourer.

7. preventing migration: One district one product of UP which based on traditional industries will provide jobs in native region.

Financial and social security, educational, infrastructural policies are need around the migrants which will be backbone for developing India.
