


Do you think that the Shanghai Cooperation Organization can stabilize the uncertainties in Afghanistan? Comment (200 words).

- > Afghanistan, Nepal, Sri Lanka, Maldives, Iran are currently in the observer list.




- * Altogether the cooperation among countries is obtained by mutual trust, security, shared equality, respect, dignity towards each interests & aspirations.
