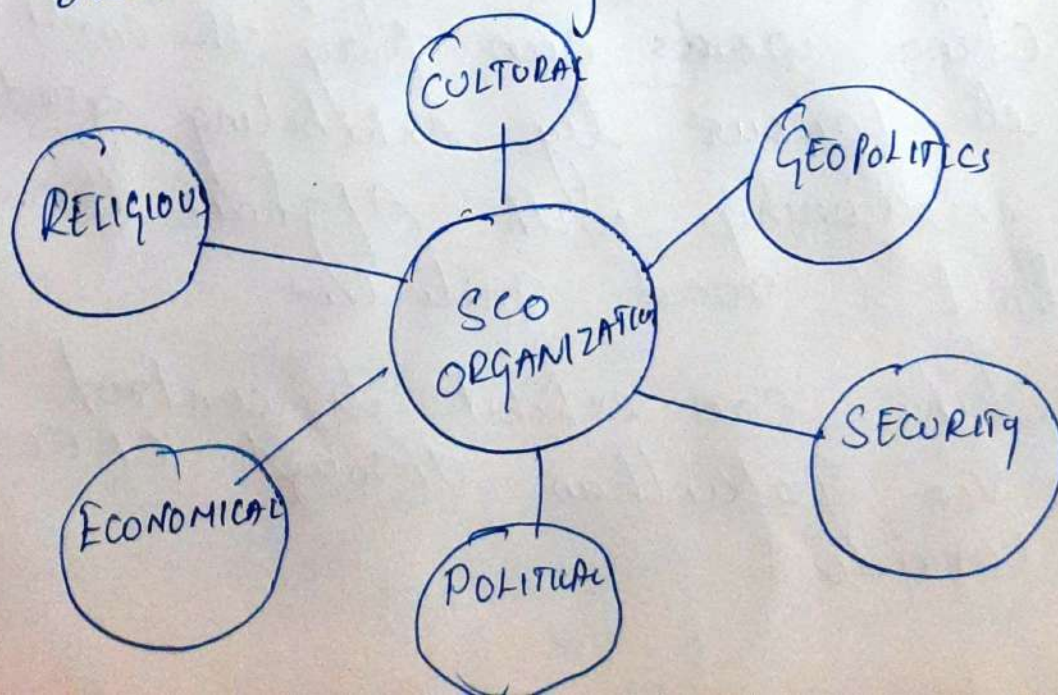


Do you think that the Shanghai Cooperation Organization can stabilize the uncertainties in Afghanistan? Comment (200 words).

- > Afghanistan, Nepal, Sri Lanka, Maldives, Iran are currently in the observer list.



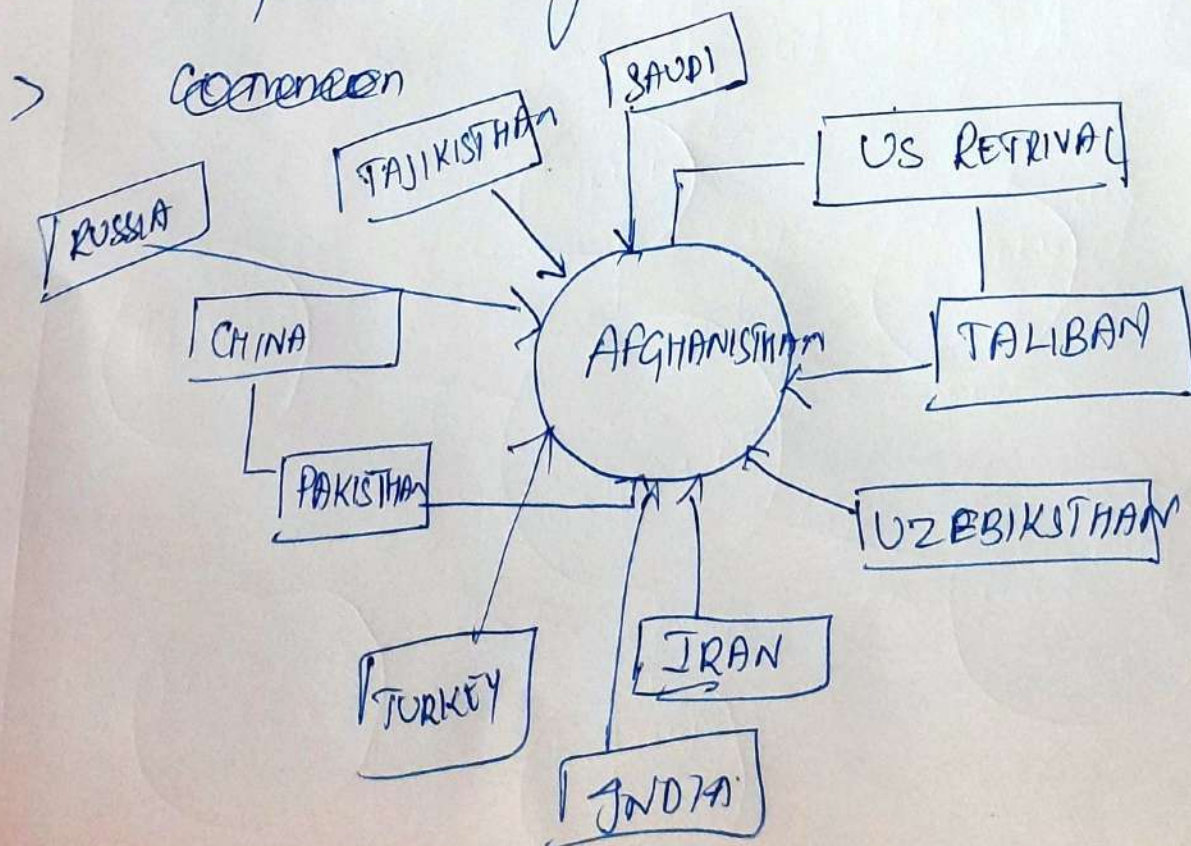

- > China can exhibit its control via Pakistan through CPBC Corridor
